

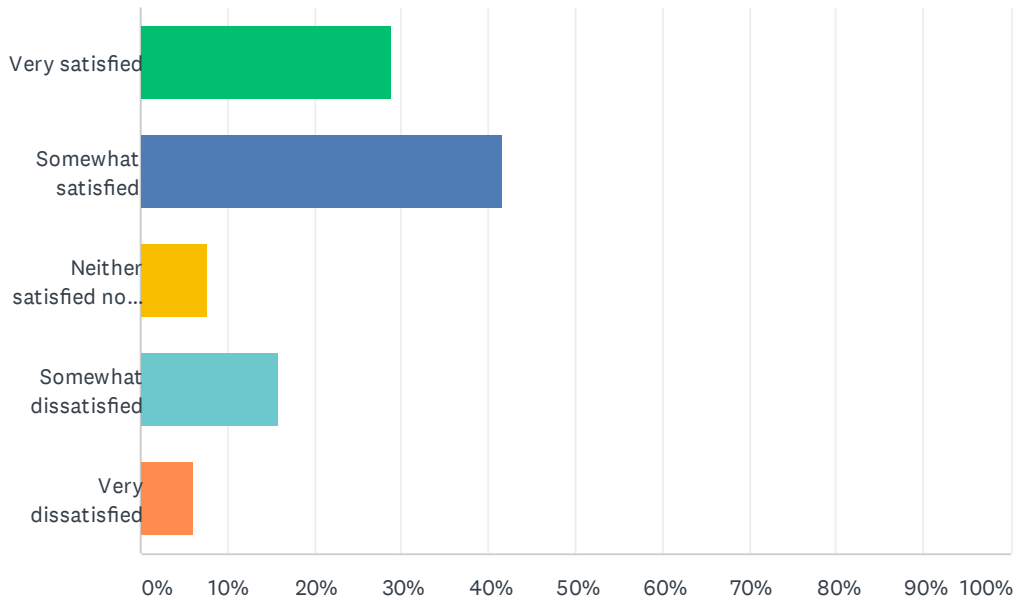

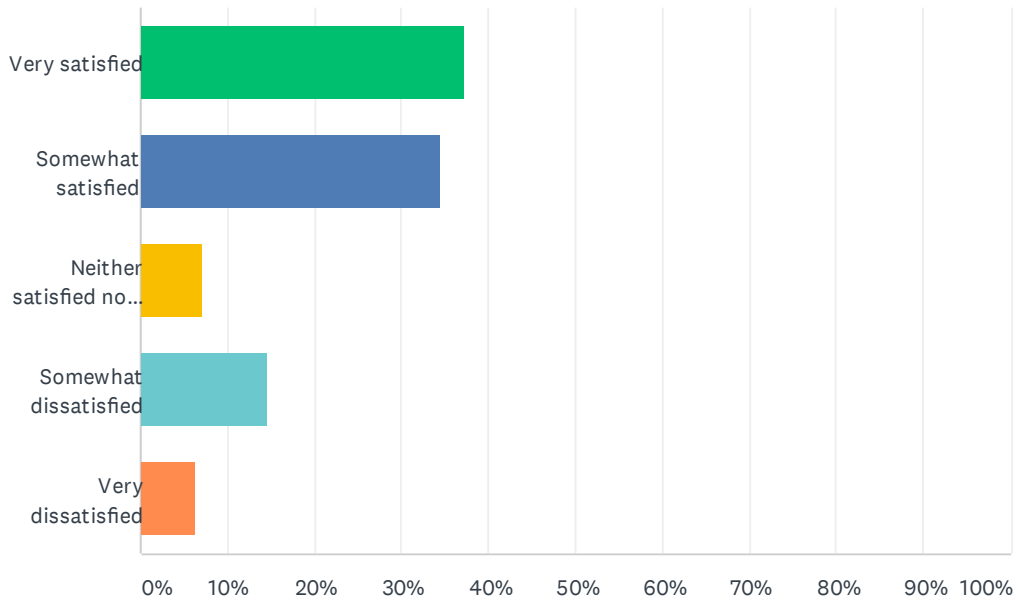

Q3 How satisfied are you with the cleaning regime in your school?

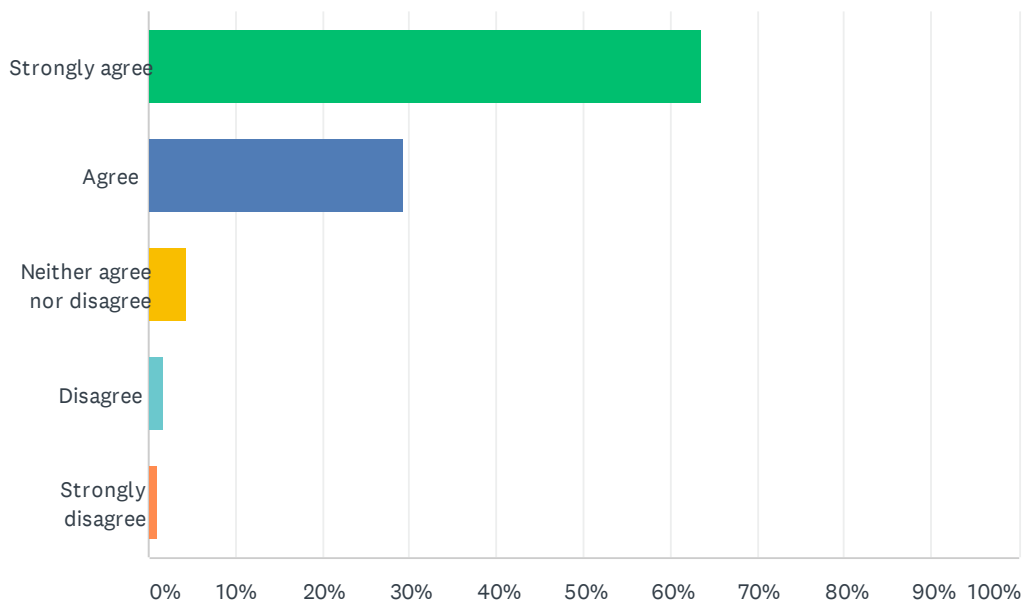

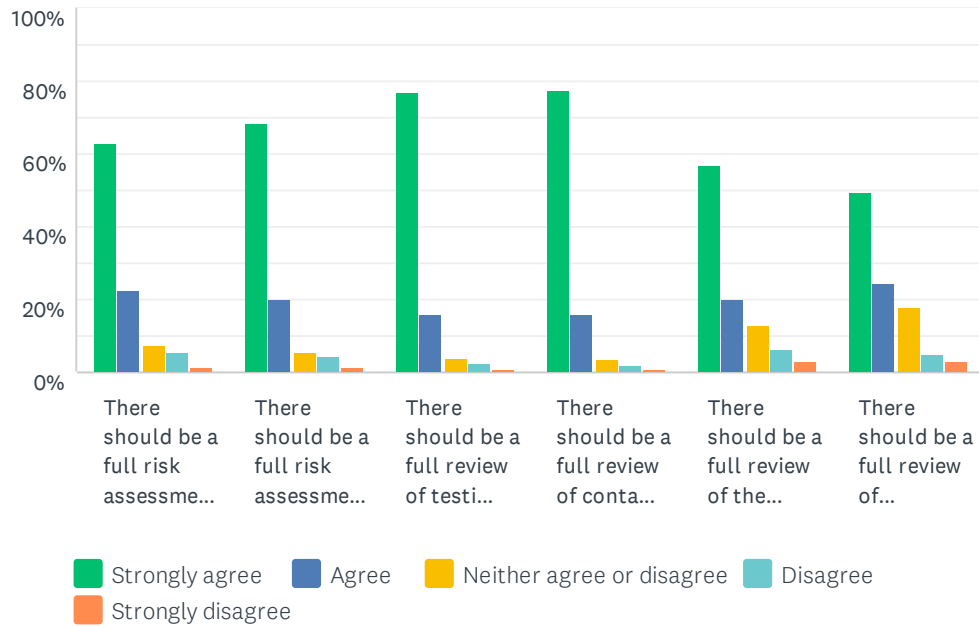

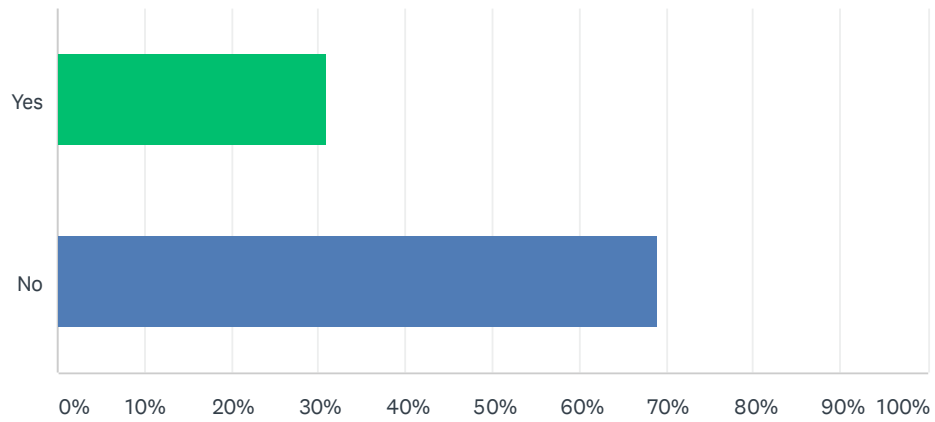

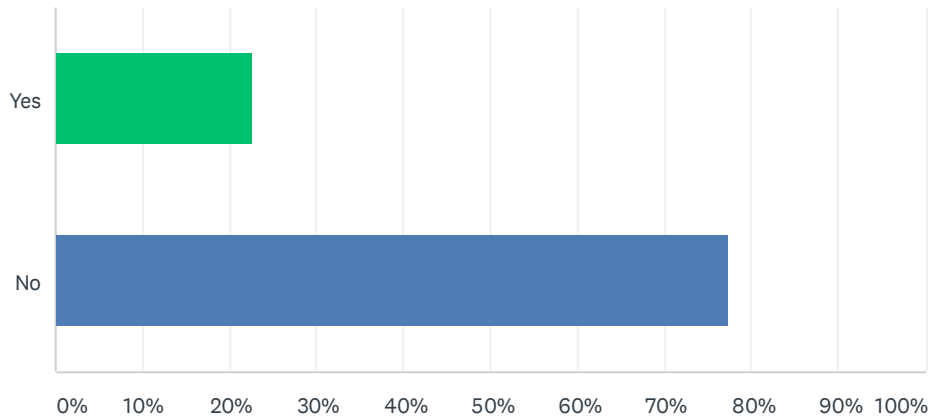

Q7 Do you live with a person who is highly vulnerable to Covid-19 that would make it difficult for you to return to school and/or classroom teaching?

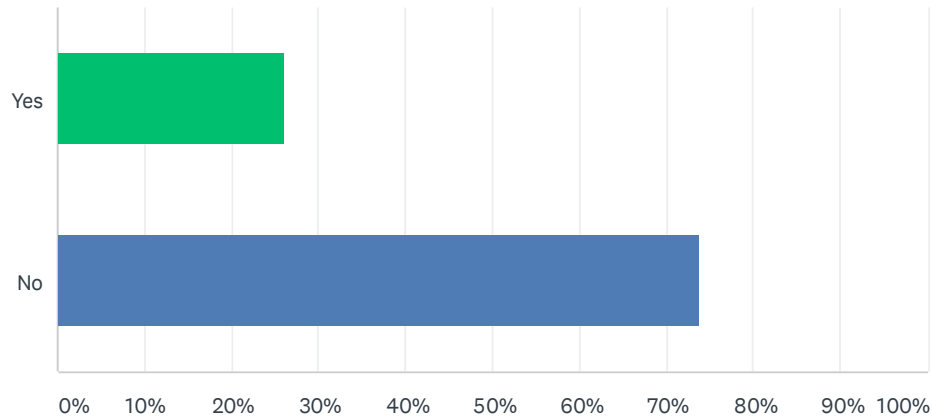

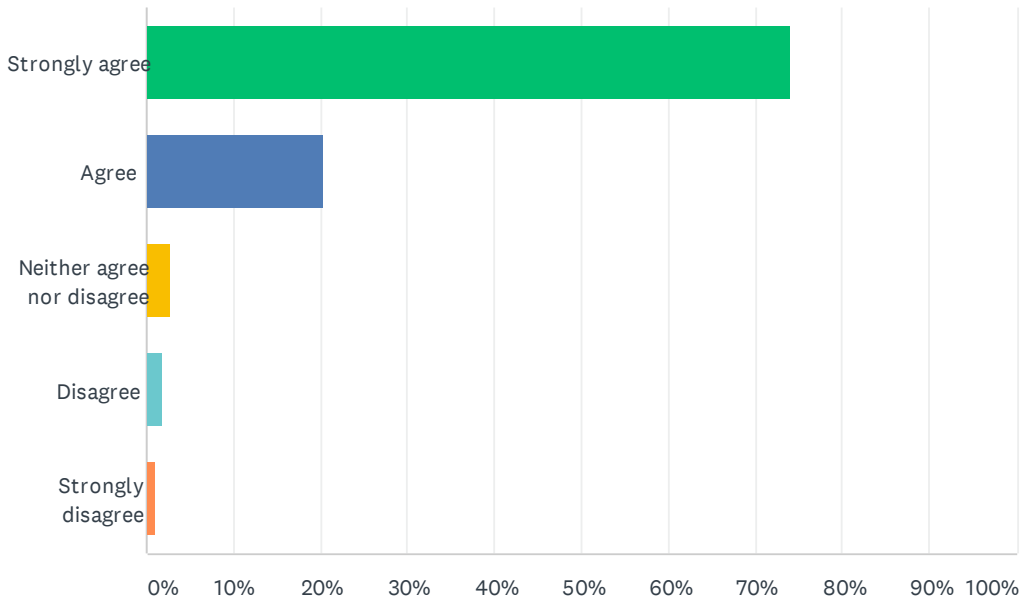

Q9 It has been stated that transmission rates of the Covid-19 virus within the wider community need to be reduced to manageable levels before schools are reopened. Do you agree with this position?

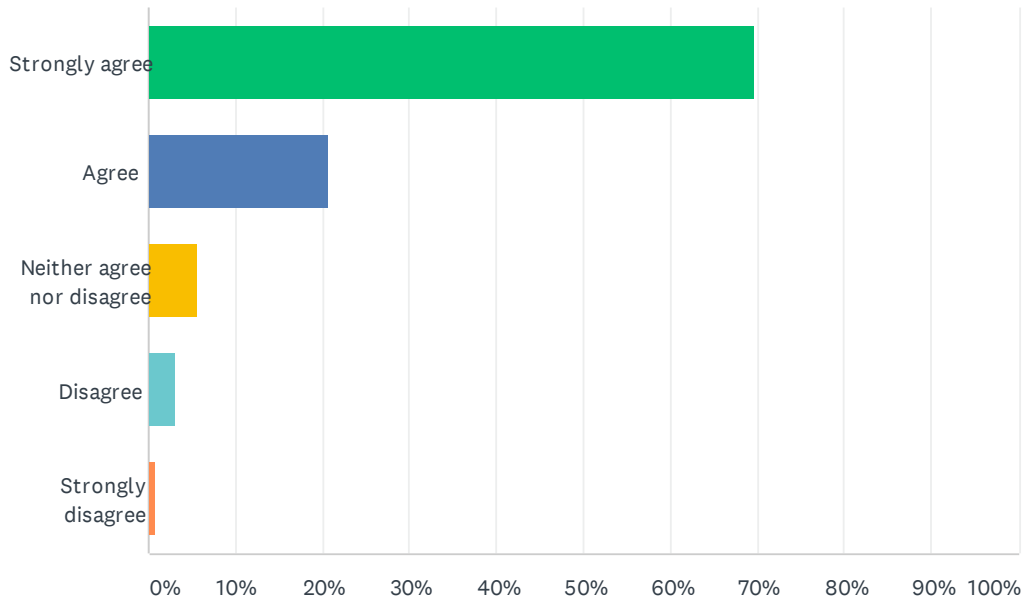

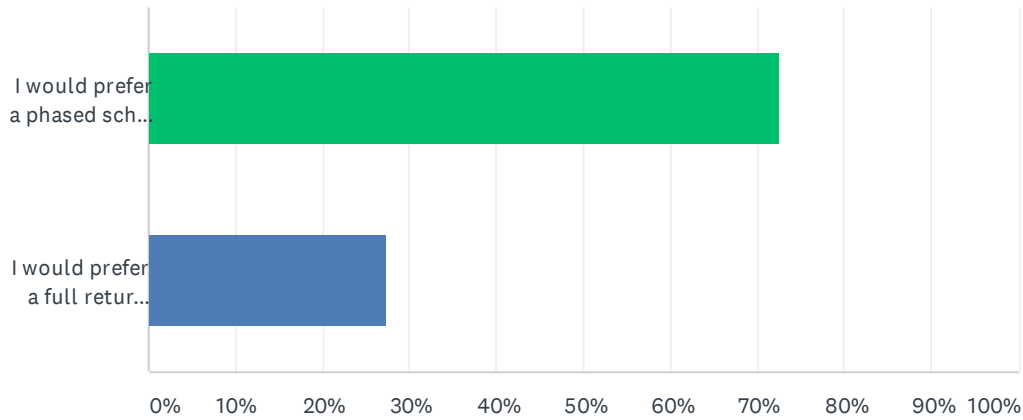

Q11 Which would you prefer – a phased reopening of schools involving prioritised group(s) or a full reopening of schools for all members of the school community?

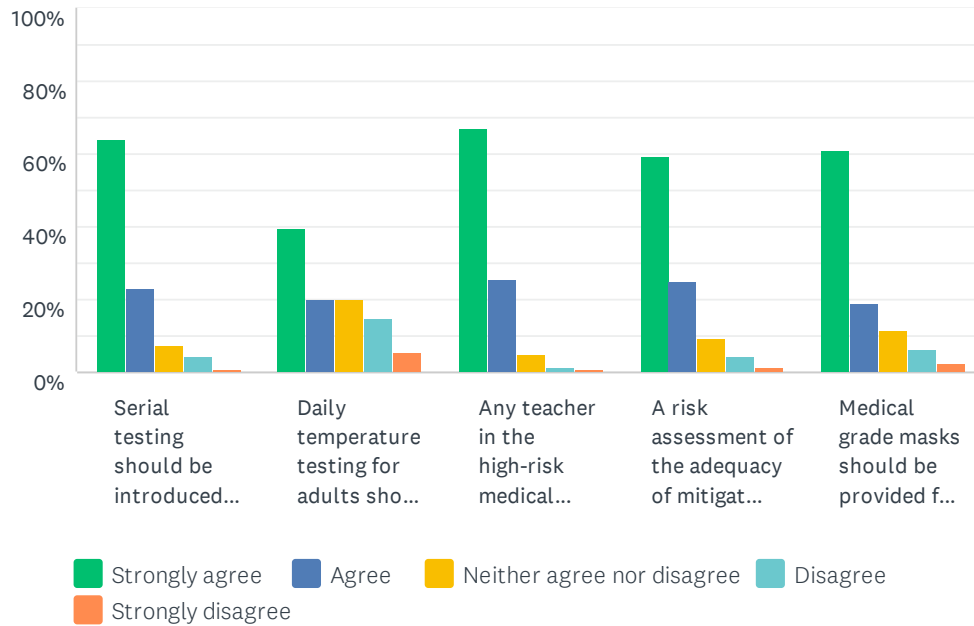

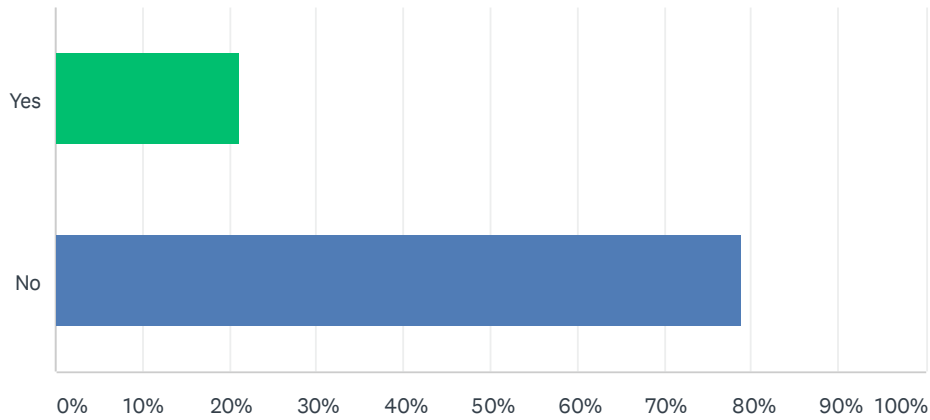
