

TEACHERS' PAY HAS ALREADY BEEN CUT

WHAT TEACHERS HAVE LOST

- ❖ Average of 7.5% pension levy which is really a pay cut.

- ❖ Pay Pause of 11 months on expiry of first module of *Towards 2016*.

- ❖ Non payment of 3.5% due on September 1st, 2009, under *Towards 2016 Review and Transitional Agreement*.

- ❖ Non payment of 2.5% due on June 1st, 2010, under *Towards 2016 Review and Transitional Agreement*.

- ❖ Curtailment of the Supervision and Substitution Scheme resulting in significant losses to part-time and temporary teachers.

- ❖ Reduced teacher allocations resulting in job losses and reduced hours and salaries for many non-permanent teachers.

- ❖ Moratorium on appointments to Assistant Principal Posts and Special Duties Posts resulting in losses respectively of €8,968 and €3,966 to hundreds of teachers.
