

NOTES

Applications must be on the standard application form – submitted by post or email to arrive by 5pm on 30th September 2026.

Confirmation of successful applicants' parent status within ASTI will be undertaken upon notification of a Bursary award.

Confirmation of University/College registration is required upon notification of a Bursary award.

The five award winners of €1,000 and one winner of €5,000 in 2025 will be drawn by lot.

Only one application per student is permitted to be entered into the draw. Multiple applications will disqualify.

Applicants for the Miriam Duggan ASTI Bursary Award will also be included in the draw for the other five bursaries.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Children of ASTI members or ASTI staff members are eligible to apply.
2. Applications will be accepted from eligible applicants who are commencing or have already commenced an undergraduate course in a third-level institution – proof of acceptance will be required.
3. The ASTI will only accept applications for full-time courses. The third-level institution may be any of the institutions as set out by the CAO. It may also be based outside of Ireland.
4. One application per student is permitted to be entered into the draw. Multiple applications will disqualify.
5. Applicants for the Miriam Duggan ASTI Bursary Award will also be included in the draw for the other five bursaries.
6. The award-winning students will receive their Bursary payment in one instalment of €1,000 in October 2026. Notwithstanding the foregoing, proof of attendance and/or acceptance in writing of the applicants' chosen course must be provided to the ASTI before the Bursary is paid.
7. The Bursary draw will be undertaken by the ASTI President or Vice President (as available) and overseen by an independent observer.
8. Those awarded a Bursary may not enter the draw in subsequent years.
9. In applying for the Bursary draw, the winner is agreeing to participate in promotional activities such as photo opportunities or videos arranged by ASTI. The winner is also agreeing to their name and photograph as the winner of the Bursary being used across ASTI's publications, social media and press media outlets.
10. The decision of the officers of the ASTI is final on all matters relating to the Bursary awards and draw. No correspondence will be entered into.
11. The awarding of the Bursary is not subject to appeal.
12. The ASTI reserves the right to alter any of these terms and conditions at its sole discretion as is necessary, at any time, and without prior notice.
